The Commissioner of Revenue Office is responsible for assessing personal property and machinery and tools within Washington County and for maintaining the County's real estate and personal property tax records. The Commissioner's office also spends considerable time working on state income taxes, helping citizens complete their state returns and performing initial processing prior to delivery of the forms to the State Department of Taxation. Other duties include: implementing local programs such as Tax Relief for the Elderly and Disabled Homeowner, as well as validation and re-validation of the Land Use Program.
